Rules & FAQ

- Books will be selected 12 months in advance (6 books at all times).
- A member can select a book once they have attended 3 monthly book discussions within 1 year. The member who selects the book may act as guest facilitator if they wish. The member may either choose a book that fits the next available slot criteria, or may choose a different book that will fit at a later time.
- In order to ensure in-depth discussion, participants should read the book prior to the bi-monthly meeting.
- Bi-Monthly meetings occur on the 2nd Wednesday of every other month.
- Books should be fewer than 500 pages in length.
- Participants should prepare one question or observation about the selected book prior to the meeting.
- Disrespectful or distracting behavior will not be tolerated.

What does it mean to have a Lit Mind?

Having a Lit Mind includes an openness to different ideas, interest in viewing literature from a global perspective, and engagement in thought-provoking, respectful discussion.

Who is this book club for?

Anyone who loves to read, wants to explore new types of literature, and is open minded and respectful of others' ideas.

Who chooses the books?

The first several books have been chosen by the facilitators using guidelines that consider the genre, age of the book and the author's geography, ethnicity, gender, and cultural background. After attending three sessions, participants can recommend a book, which will then be approved by the facilitators.

How do I join?

What will happen at the book club meetings?

After participants arrive and sign in, facilitators will use pre-written prompts and/or questions to generate a group discussion for approximately an hour. Towards the end of the session each participant will have the chance to voice any final thoughts about the book. Participants who choose the book of the month will have the opportunity to facilitate the discussion for that session, although that is not required.

What materials do I need to participate?

Acquire a copy of the book of the month either through local bookstores ([The Twig Book Shop](#), [Nowhere Bookshop](#), and [Dead Tree Books](#)), the [San Antonio Public Library](#), or any other place you get your books from. Please note participants are required to read the book prior to the monthly meeting. You can find a list of upcoming books on Gemini Ink's website.
