What is the Teen Writing Circle?

A monthly online writing space where teens can create in a judgment-free environment.

Who is the facilitator?

Daniel Ramirez is a San Antonio-based educator with over 15 years of experience working with youth. He creates a supportive space where teens can explore creativity and storytelling.

What kind of writing will it focus on?

The teen writing circle focuses on creative writing, including poetry, fiction, and creative nonfiction.

What will happen in each meeting?

Each meeting includes short writing activities to get ideas flowing. You're welcome to share your work and receive feedback—sharing is always optional. You can also bring writing from outside the circle.

What is expected of me?

- Participants are encouraged to keep their cameras on
- Respectful, constructive feedback
- Attendance encouraged but flexible
- No homework

What am I getting out of it?

- Exposure to new genres and styles
- A space to connect with other teen writers
- Mentorship from a working writer
- Opportunities to build confidence and leadership
- A growing creative community
- Resources to continue your writing
- Opportunities to share work publicly
